We are pleased to announce that we are able to fund our program at last years level of \$21,000. Over the past eight years we have awarded an average of \$18,000 per year.

Program Information

There are many actions taking place behind the scenes to support our programs. We have a very active Board of Directors who combine to volunteer hundreds of hours each month to manage the club's business and activities. In addition to our regular work, this past month we focused on:

- Scholarship program / funding
- Our constitution and by-laws
- A membership survey

Our Scholarship program is supported by donations, investments, membership dues and ongoing fundraising activities. A majority of our funds are limited for withdrawal and are held in reserve leaving a limited amount to fund scholarships and administration. We can sustain our program for another seven years and must be cautious in our operations.

Our Constitution and By-Laws are updated periodically as the organization evolves. Our members will vote to adopt amendments at our annual meeting this June. Update: The Multnomah Athletic Club has been scheduled as the site for our Annual Meeting.

Our Membership Survey was designed to assess the needs and interests of our members. Thank you to the first 44 members who completed the survey at the last Tea. We hope to achieve 100%.
