As I reflect on my 2023-24 year as president of Monday Musical Club of Portland, there is much I would like to say. Most importantly, I would like to thank the MMC Board for their hard work and dedication to making MMC the best that it can be.

Monday Musical Club's Vision for the year 2023-2024 was "to expand the organization with new members, raise money for music awards, provide music education, and empower our community to thrive through music."

Highlights that support our vision throughout the year include:

- Fall Sampler~ fundraiser at a lovely private home.
- "Bring a Friend"~ encouraging new memberships. To date, MMC has 21 new members!
- MMC Holiday Luncheon and Raffle at the Multnomah Athletic Club, Portland.
- Implementation of the 1st ever "Crescendo Master Class Series." They were designed to
 prepare students auditioning for Monday Musical Club's 2024 Awards Program. Distinguished
 artists reviewed each student's musical performance and provided feedback. The performance
 areas included: instrumental, piano, and vocal. It proved to be a very educational experience
 for both the students and audience.
- Spring Concert Amazing Fundraising Event for MMC Awards Program.
- Nicoletta's Table Restaurant Fundraiser Event ~ All proceeds from the "tip jar" were donated to MMC.
- Award Winners Performance & Tea
 - MMC Music Awards Program gave \$16,500 to music students in our local area.
 Additionally
 - MMC contributes \$1000.00 each to Portland Youth Philharmonic, Metropolitan Youth Symphony, the Community Music Center, Piano Santa, the Oregon Symphony, and Portland Opera.



- A fundraising effort to promote Donors & Sponsors of Monday Musical Club of Portland is currently underway. Mailings to Cultural Arts and Musical groups, Corporate and Individual Sponsorships, are ongoing. We have also made it easier to donate by using a credit card (Mastercard, Visa, AMEX, Discover). MMC is a better organization because of our donors and supporters.
- MMC is making a conscious effort to publicize and get information out about Monday Musical Club and what we're all about. Efforts are being made to get on TV (AM Northwest) and All Classical radio.
- Monday Musical Club was founded in 1904 and has supported music in our community for 120 years!
